The treasurer's report for this month was unanimously accepted.

Budget Discussion

Plan to spend some savings to balance the budget as we round out 2022-23, will need to do the same for 23-24.

In general, pledge level has been steady the past 5 years, averaging \$70,000. However, our expenses have increased. Expenses have continued to rise-including bringing Rev. Eileen's salary to align with UUA mid-range expectations at her 7th year of service (2.5% increase) Music director salary should increase to get somewhat closer to UUA recommendations. Investments were made in the buildings and grounds (basement upgrade and playground). No increase in pledge amounts.COVID PPE grants provided significant income which helped balance expenses; however, that was unique and will not repeat.

Savings is approximately \$58-60k with the majority in a CD.

Geoff recommends maintaining course with minister's salary, need to reduce amount drawn from savings to balance the budget.
